Erasmus+ funding 2021-2027

- Council and Parliament agreement of 13th November:

EUR 23.4 billion for Erasmus+ (2014-2020: EUR 14.7 billion)

- Details for international actions not yet specified.

(2014-2020: €163 million DCI funds for LA + Additional funding for competition between all world countries in Erasmus Mundus and Jean Monnet)

- First call is delayed.
- Some actions, including CBHE, won't have a call 2021, but will reappear in 2022

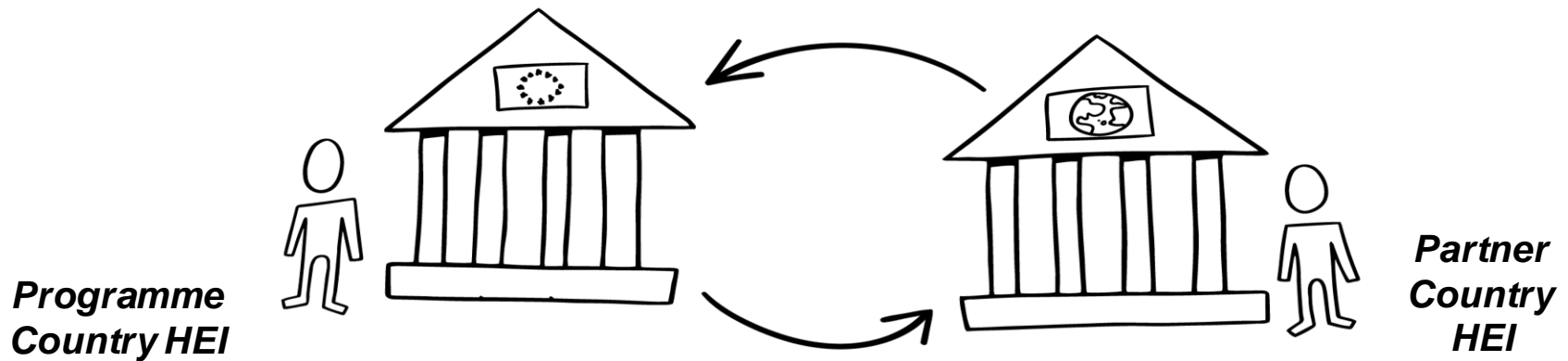

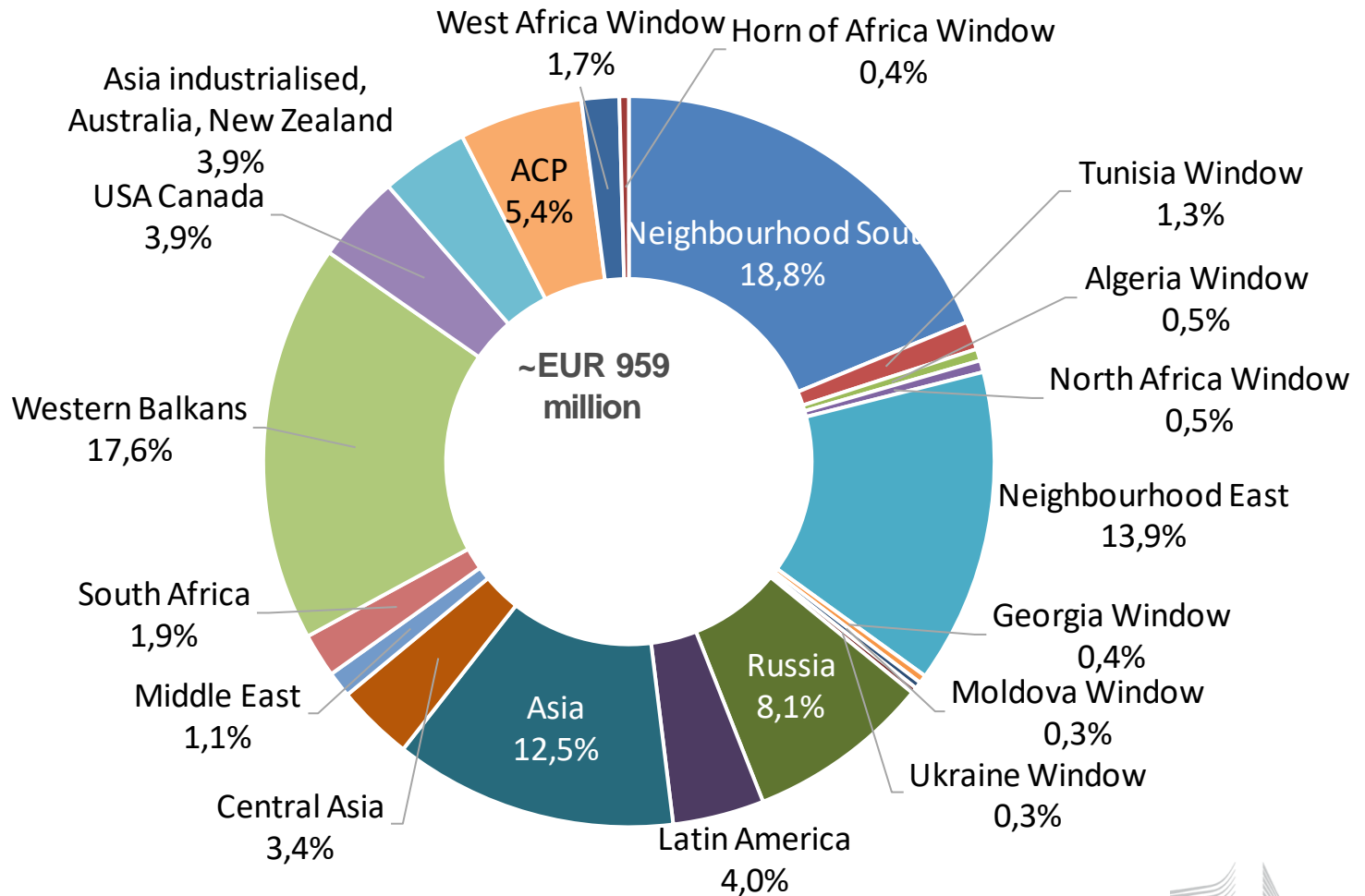

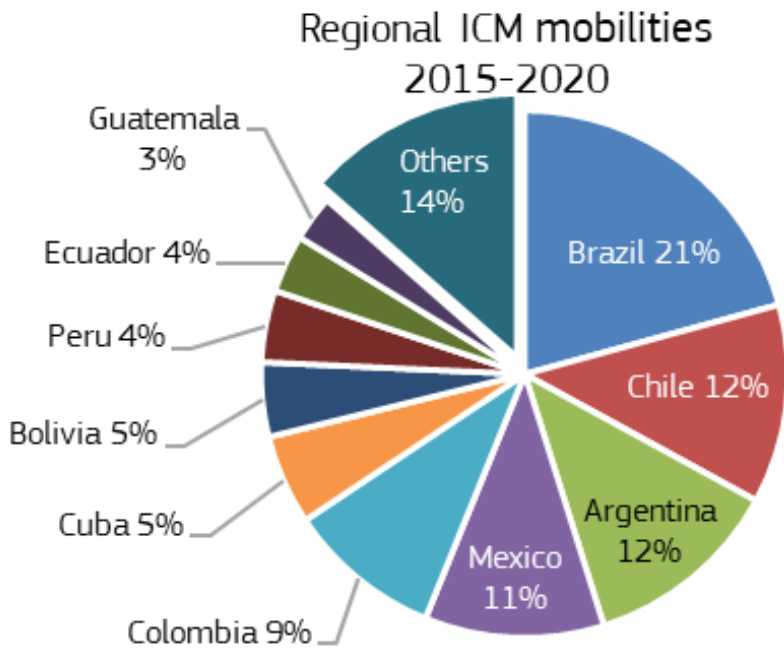

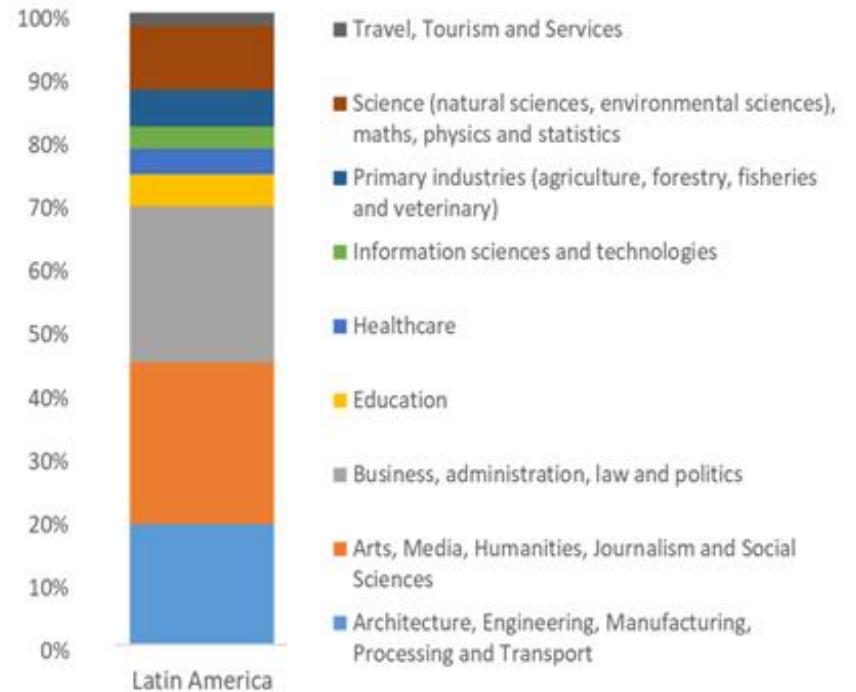
ICM budget 2014-2020

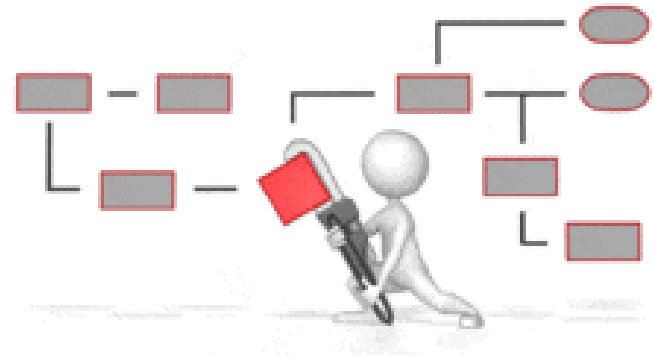
