## ❖ To purchase the **EQUIPMENT**



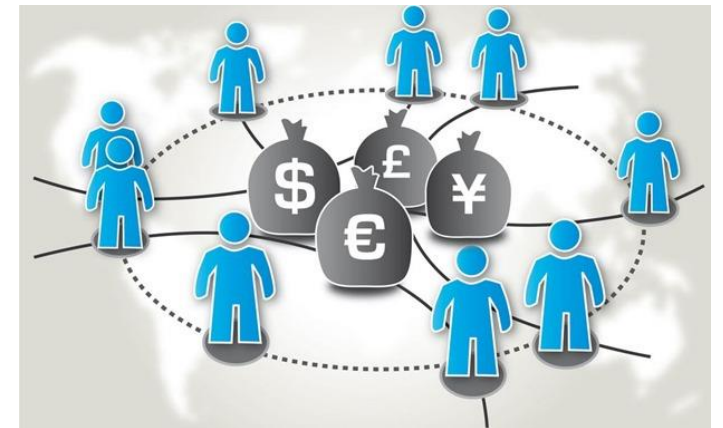
- ✓ A complex process for the Latin American institutions

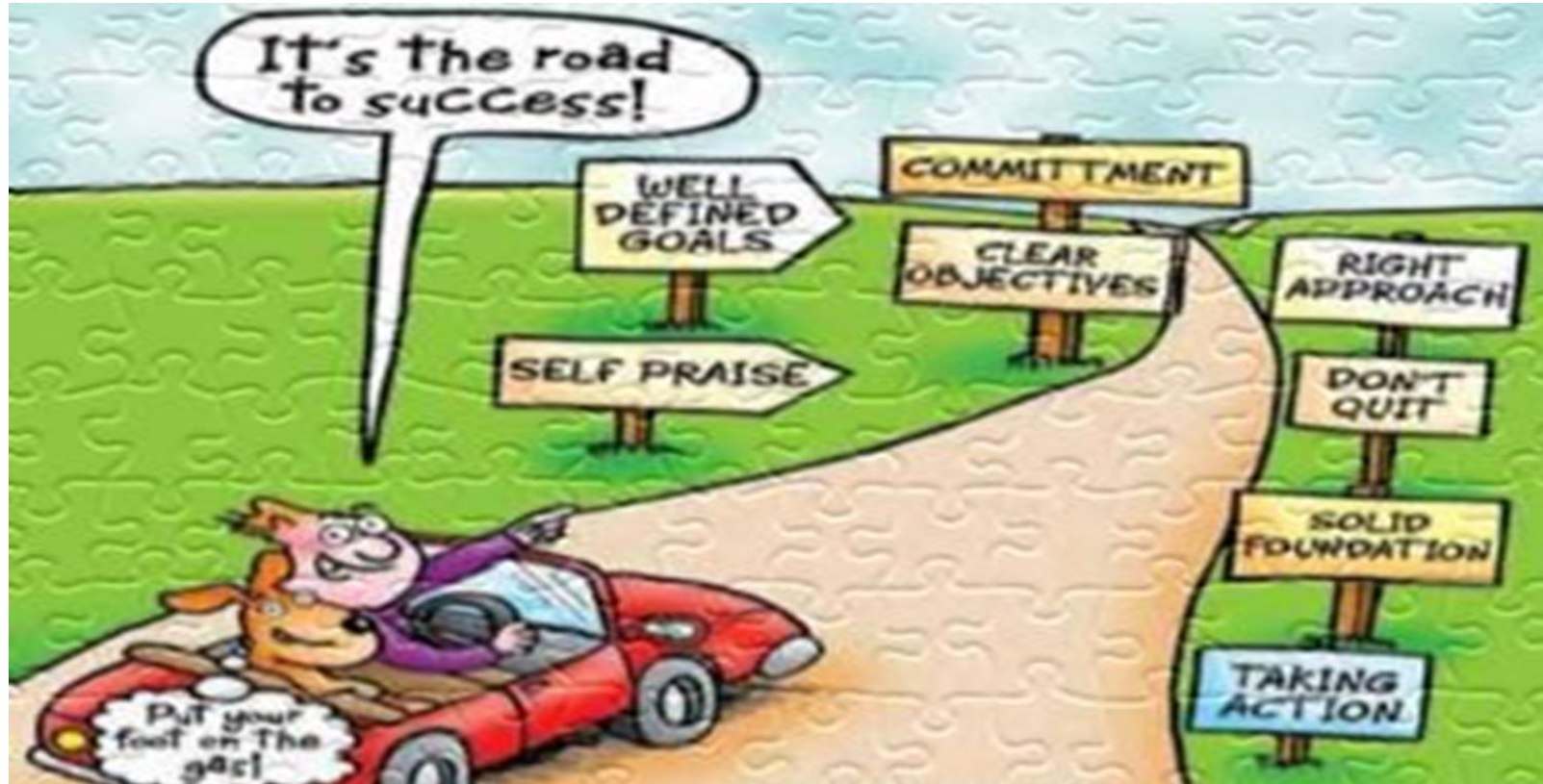
## ❖ COVID Restrictions
